### Guidelines for Student International Travel

Given the COVID-19 situation and the accompanying travel restrictions both domestic and international, we had notified you the guidelines by e-mail dated June 8, 2022, but the following guidelines considered on the Overseas Travel Safety information issued by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs (MOFA) will apply to student international travel from April 1, 2023.

- 
- "Travel Advice and Warning" or "Travel Advice and Warning on Infectious Diseases" by MOFA is Level 1 or lower  
→ Exercise caution when travel
  - "Travel Advice and Warning" or "Travel Advice and Warning on Infectious Diseases" by MOFA is Level 2  
→ Avoid non-essential travel
  - "Travel Advice and Warning" or "Travel Advice and Warning on Infectious Diseases" by MOFA is Level 3 or higher  
→ Avoid all travel

#### ※Notes※

In principle, travel where "Avoid non-essential travel" applies is prohibited.

If there is a special reason that you really need to travel abroad, please notify the Student Affairs Department at least one month before your travel. However, depending on the reason for travel, JAIST may not allow travel at the discretion of the Dean, Trustee and Vice President for Educational and Student Affairs.

#### 【Matters to be observed for International Travel】

《 1 》 You must obtain the approval from your own supervisor beforehand and submit the "Notice of Temporary Leave" handed to the International Student Section.

《 2 》 Students are required to get either an overseas travel insurance or a local insurance that provides sufficient compensation for the entire period of the travel.

《 3 》 You must confirm in advance the quarantine measures set by the host government and host institution, and strictly comply with local laws and regulations upon entry.

《 4 》 When returning to Japan, you must strictly comply with the quarantine measures and the Border Measures set by Japanese government.

« 5 » In preparation for emergencies while traveling abroad, you must always make your whereabouts clear and keep your family and supervisor updated.
